Poor behaviour needs to be dealt with quickly  
Keeping parents informed when there are incidents at school at lunchtime  
More homework

I am delighted that so many of you chose to respond to the questionnaires. We are very pleased with the overwhelmingly positive comments and will with the tiny percentage of parents who have concerns:

We have made huge progress in a short space of time with our positive behaviour policy but a couple of parents commented on this as a concern.

I have discussed concerns about reporting incidents with first aiders and we hope that this will not happen again in the future.

Homework- a couple of parents want more homework but I feel that with their reading book, Bug Club access, Education City resources and the class homework set by the teacher, there are many opportunities for your child to be involved in learning at home.
