We had an assessment day last term which many parents attended. The English classes run by the council for these parents have now started and are on a weekly basis. We hope to run more assessment days in the future.

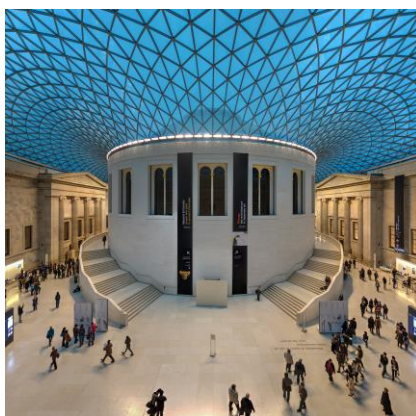
New behaviour policy
