The competitions were; Football, Girls Football, B- Team Football, Netball, Girls Cricket, Boys Cricket and Athletics. The impact was that these children had the opportunity to experience and play and compete against other schools in a competitive environment. Children taking part in external competitions they grew confidence as a result.</p> <p>16 children took part in B- team competitions. These pupils were able to compete fairly with other children who are at the same level of skill and ability.</p> <p>10 girls attended a female only football level 2 competitions. Girls regularly attended a football club after the competition and play football at lunchtimes.</p> <p>KS1 and KS2 sports days were held at Swift Road where every child had the opportunity to compete in a range of different sports that involved agility, balance and coordination.</p>
